alliative Medicine is a relatively new branch of medicine which focuses on the care of patients suffering from chronic progressive conditions as well as life-limiting illness such as cancer and end-stage organ failure.

Patients facing life limiting illnesses as well as their families often confront physical, emotional, socio-economic and spiritual distress, which adversely affect the quality of their life. Palliative Care addresses these issues by providing 'Total Care' to the patient at their home environment through a 'Team Work Approach', incorporating not only various Medical Professionals but also Volunteers from the Community.

The Aim of Palliative Care is to alleviate the suffering of such patients by providing relief from pain and other distressing physical symptoms, to provide emotional support by adequate counseling to both the patient and the family, to empower the family and to care for patients at home and to working with community to ensure social and spiritual support.

It is a pity that in our country only 2 % of the patients receive palliative care. Extending access to a much wider community, and to where it matters, is therefore of paramount importance and a key goal of our out-reach programmes.









Palliative Care neither intends to hasten nor postpone death; but focuses on ensuring the best quality of life for the patient till the very end.

Neuro-rehabilitation physiotherapy. Monday thru Saturday (9 a.m. to 5 p.m.)

Patients with restricted mobility due to accidents, deseases like stroke, polio, people with mentally challenged etc. are transported to the physiotherapy centres for regular care consistently.

Weddings of Unwed Daughters

Wedding of the close relatives is found to be a major emotional concern of the patient. Consequently Alpha has devised a project for conducting the marriages of daughters and sisters of patients who cannot afford the wedding expenses. Bride-grooms are selected by the family. Alpha provides the arrangements for the marriages as per the customs and rites. Cash gift of Rs. 50,000 and 40 grms.gold jewellery. Sadya (feast) is prepared and served by volunteers. Cultural programmes are conducted by Alpha Kalavedi (A cultural club of patients children). Marriages are contected twice every year. 45 girls got married todate.

Santhwana Samanuayam

Santhwana Samanuayam is network of voluntary supporters who donate every month to Alpha. Volunteers run subscription campaigns at their own time. Revenue goes directly to patient care. It is a novel example of community participation.

Alpha Homes

12 small flats have been provided for patients who lost their homes due to expensive treatments.

Alpha ITI

An Industrial Training Institute with State of the Art features to empower patients' families by providing free technical education to their children. The institute is also open to the public.

Alpha Care Home

Alpha Care Home is another venture. It is a home for elderly orphans where people from various religious faiths live together in complete harmony.



ALPHA LINK CENTRES

Alpha Palliative care would like to establish Hospices with inpatient admision and Physiotherapy facilities in every district capital. Under the supervision of the Hospices and clinical teams, Link Centres with physiotherapy and Vocational Training facilities will be set-up in every block panchyat and major city. These will be owned, financed and operated by the local community.

Working with Alpha staff, trained community volunteers, based in these Link Centres, will address the emotional, spiritual, social and financial problems faced by patients and their families and attempt to find a solution locally.





STUDENTS FOR PALLIATIVE CARE INITIATIVE

Alpha Palliative Care is bringing the young and vibrant student community to spread the message and engage them in Palliative Care projects. Alpha's initiative of "One rupee one Life" is a scheme which encourages each child to contribute one rupee from his/her pocket money towards patients' care.
